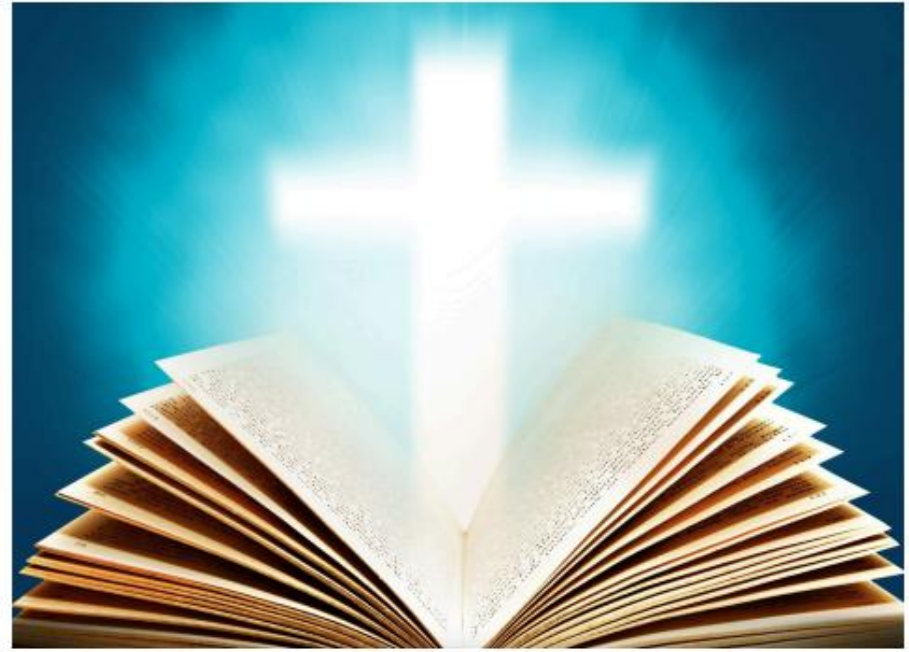

Jn. 1:1-5, 14

- A. Who do you say the Son of Man is?
 - 1. Paul wrote—Rom. 10:9-10
 - 2. Jesus asked His disciples—Matt. 16:13-17
 - 3. John said—Jn. 20:30-31
- B. What is the Point? —Dan. 7:13-14
 - 1. Jesus is more than a man
 - 2. He is the Glorious Christ
- C. Does it matter—absolutely
 - 1. If He is not God, then you and I are still in our sins [“Gethsemane,” Jesus Christ Superstar]
 - 2. We do not have God on a cross
 - 3. Therefore, Jesus has no permanent significance and no immediate benefit
 - a. That he came historically, vitally, relevantly, and savingly
 - b. What is the relevance of the statement, His word abides forever
 - c. What is the value of His lifestyle that He asks of us—servanthood, submission, love
 - d. Why show up on a Sunday to worship a man
 - e. It is the greatest con-trick in the world
 - 4. We really do not know God the Father and what He is like
 - a. No man has seen God (1 Tim. 6:14-16)
 - b. Jesus is the One that explains Him (Jn. 1:18)
- D. What does it mean when we say: Jesus is God? (Jn. 1:1-5, 14)
 - 1. Co-eternal with the Father
 - 2. Co-equal with the Father
 - 3. Co-divine with the Father
 - 4. Co-creator with the Father
 - 5. The One who brings grace and truth
- E. Hence, the Son of Man is:
 - 1. Messiah
 - 2. Son of God
 - 3. Savior
 - 4. The Glorious Lord of Creation
